## Caroline LAFFARGUE

### Approach:

Caroline LAFARGUE was born in Strasbourg, Eastern France in 1971, where she lives today. She has been painting for over 12 years after graduating in design and arts.

Her paintings reflect her love for raw material as well as traveling and meeting people. Caroline's work soaked up ethnic themes before shifting towards a more occidental approach.

There is a dual side to the exhibited artwork. It orbits around an urban approach: buildings, blocs and life in the streets of the United States. Caroline LAFFARGUE 's work renders the aspects that heckle her the most : Atmosphere, overgrowth, straight shapes, perspectives, colors ...

She also presents urban women "Les Citadines," the reflection of our society, the projection of myths that they carry sometimes unintentional icons. From those female subjects she extracts a different kind of beauty: sensuality and finesse from intimate contexts that invite the viewer to imagine a story around the picture.

The representational iconographies remind us of comic books. They become associated to the abstract - collage of different raw materials, transparency, balance of shades, of colors and other mediums – to finally become the subject of the artwork.

Without a doubt the painter enjoys clouding the issue between the image, the picture and the comic book ...
